The University of Virginia Ryan White Clinic (UVARWC) (est. 1998) is the only significant provider of HIV-related primary health services in the Virginia Department of Health Northwest Health Region. 96% of the region is considered rural as described by the 2010 U.S. Census.

UVARWC provides comprehensive medical services including medical care, obstetrical/gynecological care, mental health services, substance use treatment, emergency medications, stabilization, and medical transport. The UVARWC operates with the critical support of Ryan White funding.

The percentage of uninsured clinic patients decreased from approx. 54% (2013) to 12% (2017).



Approximately 30% of clinic patients have Virginia ADAP funded ACA insurance plans.
