The Division also runs a clinical research program to bring innovative treatment options to patients. The Division operates with the critical support of Ryan White funding.

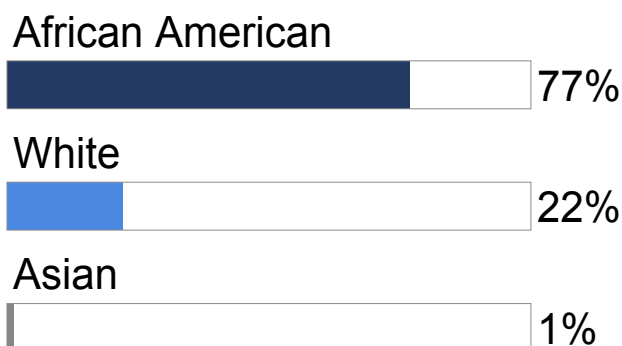
