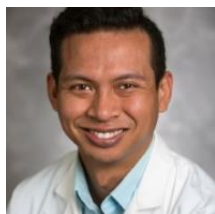
Dr. Taylor Schmidt is pursuing his HIV clinical training at the UT Southwestern Medical Center under the mentorship of James Cutrell, MD and Ellen Kitchell, MD. Dr. Schmidt became interested in HIV medicine during his residency training during which he had the opportunity to manage patients with HIV in an outpatient clinic and to care for patients with AIDS in the medical intensive care unit (ICU). Seeing patients with AIDS in the ICU highlighted for him the importance of having primary care physicians better trained to manage HIV to prevent disease progression. Following his fellowship training, Dr. Schmidt plans to continue to work with the underserved community in a primary care setting that caters to the HIV population. Dr Schmidt completed his residency training at UT Southwestern Medical Center and received his medical degree from UT Southwestern Medical Center.
